Dr. Rajiv Reebye is a Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (PMR) specialist and Clinical Associate Professor in the department of Medicine at UBC. He is an attending physician on the inpatient neuro-musculoskeletal program (NMS) and on the outpatient acquired brain injury and NMS programs at GF Strong Rehabilitation Center. He sees patients for post-stroke rehabilitation needs at GF Strong Rehabilitation Centre and community outpatient clinic in New Westminster, BC as well as hospital-based consulting practice at Royal Columbian Hospital.

Dr. Reebye is the director of the New Westminster Rehabilitation Medicine spasticity clinic- a community-based spasticity clinic focusing on the treatment of patients with adult post-stroke spasticity.
