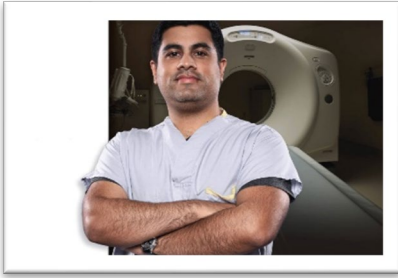


Dr. Tarun Sharma, Cardiologist

He is board certified by both Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and American Board of Internal Medicine in Internal Medicine and Cardiology, and has completed certification by American Society of Echocardiography in Adult Comprehensive Echocardiography.
